Europe's adaptation strategy to tackle human cost of climate change

The EU's climate adaptation strategy, due to be unveiled on Wednesday (24 February), will aim to tackle the human cost of climate change, both within Europe and around the world, amid calls from trade unions to reinforce protection for the most exposed workers.

Barendrecht is already planting 55 trees of a total of 1000 new ones

Barendrecht is 55 trees richer and greener. This autumn another 950 will follow. Facilitated by the Life Terra foundation, aldermen Cees Schaap (public works) and Tanja de Jonge (sustainability) planted the seedlings together with initiator and entrepreneur Wouter Onis of Mach3Builders and some volunteers. "Trees are our lifeline".

DKV plants a forest in memory of its customers who died from COVID

The Life Terra project, which plans to plant 500 million trees in the EU by 2025, today supported the work of planting a memorial forest in front of the mountains of Montserrat (Barcelona) with which employees of the DKV insurance company wanted to pay tribute to their customers who died in the pandemic.
