What we have done so far:


- **Numbers of users on web app:** 81

## **Life Terra Video – Brussels Planting Event**

On the 26th March 2021, EURACTIV teamed up with Life Terra Foundation and the [Royal Forestry Society of Belgium](#) to plant trees in the Belgian forest near Brussels.

This particular forest, 30 minutes from Brussels, was decimated by the bark beetle. A team of forestry experts and volunteers teamed up to plant over 200 trees, using Life Terra's web app to tag and track their work.



## **Life Terra Video – Delta del Llobregat**

This month on the Delta del Llobregat, EFE Verde teamed up with [De Kring](#) to focus on environmental restoration at valuable ecological sites that have been damaged because of human action. Life Terra wanted to illustrate this story with a volunteer action on Delta del Llobregat, in Barcelona province.

The Delta used to be a rich natural area that combined wetlands, pine woods, and dunes. But it is now in poor health due to habitat fragmentation and invasive species.
