Devastating forest fires in Greece

More than 580 fires have been observed in Greece since July 27, with most of them being brought under control - but the risk of forest fires still remains high. At least 120.000 hectares of forest and other natural habitats, along with many villages, were utterly destroyed.

Life Terra stands by our partners CERTH and landowners across the country. We are all grateful for the more of 1,200 firefighters that have put their lives at risk to fight these fires - firefighters from countries across Europe including Ukraine, Romania, Serbia, Slovakia, Poland, Moldova, France and Germany.

Greece is one of Life Terra's implementation countries and we are ready to start restoring the devastation that has been caused due to climate change and to help support the regrowth of biodiversity and forests across the country.

Last year, in December 2020, Rosberg X Racing planted 100 trees to offset any emissions related to its racing activities and inspire other stakeholders to also take active climate action, as part of its participation in the <a href="Extreme-Extre





Cruïlla Barcelona Festival

During the Cruïlla Barcelona festival, <u>DKV Seguros</u> - Elche installed a stand where visitors could calculate their carbon footprint caused by travelling to the festival. Of the 465 survey participants, 43 travelled to the festival emission-free. The others emitted a total amount of 6 tonnes of CO2.

DKV, @volterraecosystems, and Life Terra will plant 443 trees: 400 to compensate for the emitted carbon and 43 additional ones to say thank you to the festival visitors who left no carbon footprint. The trees will be planted in El Bruc (Barcelona), an area destroyed by fire in 2015. Native shrubs will be planted as well, in order to increase the biodiversity in the area.
