Recent Project Activities

Life Terra is expanding to France!

The already long list of countries in which Life Terra is actively planting trees keeps growing, the newest addition being France. The first events have, in fact, recently been organised in Nice, with the participation of Huawei and the European Leadership Academy. Representatives of the City of Nice, together with 28 young female leaders of the future from the 28 European countries, came together on the 24th February for a planting event inside the city. More trees will be planted in France in the future!



From Sweden to Barcelona to restore biodiversity

The engagement of the younger generations in the protection of the environment is crucial, as they will be the ones continuing the process in the future decades. To spark the interest of the children of the Escola Dolors Monserdà-Santapau in Barcelona, Life Terra and a team of 30 Prototyp employees, who came all the way from Sweden by train, organised a planting event on 11 March in the Parc de la Serralada Marina. If for the almost 50 kids this was an engaging way to spend the day with their friends at the park, for the Prototyp team it was a journey across the continent: 35 hours after the departure, they could finally get their hands dirty on the field, all while taking advantage of the occasion to explore Europe and get to know each other.

We will continue working with schools to keep inspiring more children, both through [our educational program](#) and through more planting events.



Celebrating the European Day of Forests on the field

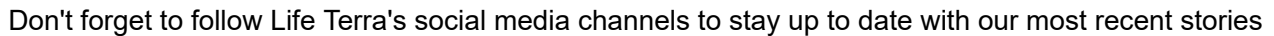
