Starting in 2019, several planting events involving the local community have been organised, with more to come in October this year. 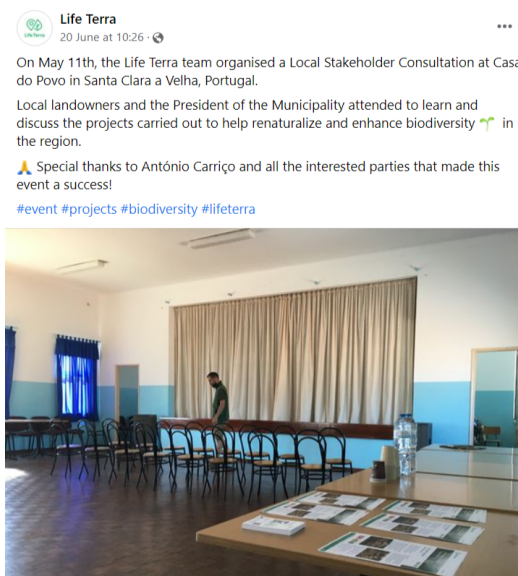
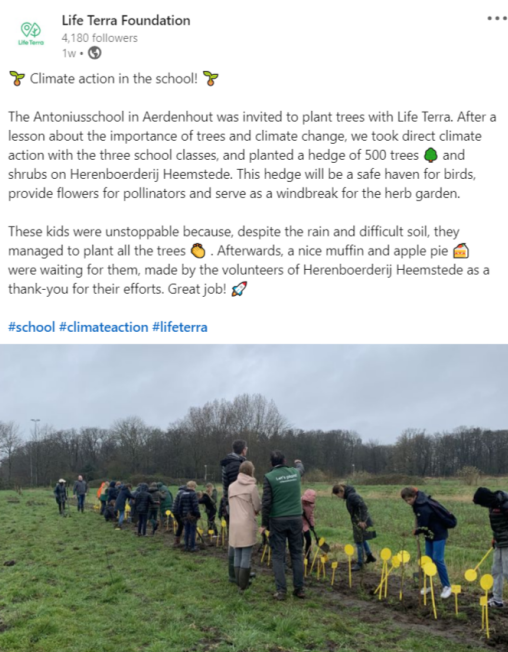
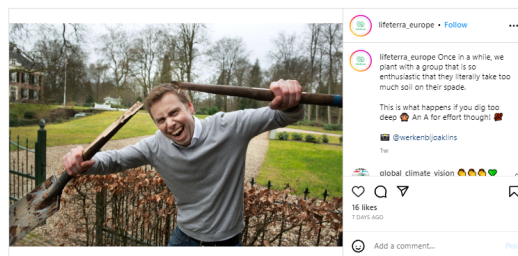
