To provide truly impactful carbon removals, Life Terra is working with Nat5 and the ASES On-Chain-Protocol to pursue carbon credits that will allow companies to compensate their footprint on nature and provide an economic benefit for landowners. These credits are on their way, with work being done in Spain and in Portugal. More information will follow!



Euractiv Virtual conference: the EU packaging waste directive and the impact on our forests

The European Commission put forward a revision of the Packaging and Packaging Waste Directive (PPWD) in November 2022. The initiative's main objective is to ensure that all packaging is reusable or recyclable in an economically feasible manner by 2030.

On 14 November, join <u>this Euractiv Virtual Conference</u> to discuss the proposed revision to the Packaging and Packaging Waste Directive. Questions to be addressed include:

- Does the Directive go far enough to reduce the environmental impact of packaging, in particular for our forests?
- Could the PPWD lead to a reduction in logging activities?
- Considering factors such as environmental and food safety measures, are there alternative packaging options available?



Inspiration from France!

At E.Leclerc, they are aware that large-scale distribution is not a neutral activity. This is why the company tried to reinvent itself with something positive and planted 1,000 trees in Ardèche, France.

These trees were planted in a damaged area with a big problem of soil erosion. These will help to slow down soil erosion and the water flow from rain. The more of +30 species planted will boost biodiversity and serve as a carbon sink.
