### **Biggest Miyawaki of Life Terra**

For the last planting of the season, Life Terra was at Granja Caimito, in the municipality of Cardeña (Córdoba, Spain). There we created a 6,000m2 Miyawaki forest, the largest to date! Our goal was to create a biodiversity hotspot by planting 21 native species to attract birds and insects and encourage the dispersal of these species to the surrounding land. This aligns with our aim for a passive restoration of the environment. We also held a workshop on the Miyawaki planting technique. Our warmest thanks to all participants!




