Recent Project Activities

Life Terra in Poland, Croatia & Slovenia

Life Terra keeps expanding around Europe - we are now active in 25 countries! This month, we were in Poland, where we planted 500 trees at Księżak, near Warsaw, Together with more than 40 kids from a local school. In Croatia, Life Terra took part in the efforts to reforest an area with oak while raising awareness about climate action. Finally, we participated in plantings in Slovenia. Fun fact: it is 3rd in Europe's ranking of most forested countries!

Demo week in Germany

Last April 10th to 12th, Life Terra organised a demo planting week close to Berlin, Germany, to showcase our planting events to some German companies and explore future collaborations with them.

Biggest Miyawaki of Life Terra

For the last planting of the season, Life Terra was at Granja Caimito, in the municipality of Cardeña (Córdoba, Spain). There we created a 6,000m2 Miyawaki forest, the largest to date! Our goal was to create a biodiversity hotspot by planting 21 native species to attract birds and insects and encourage the dispersal of these species to the surrounding land. This aligns with our aim for a passive restoration of the environment. We also held a workshop on the Miyawaki planting technique. Our warmest thanks to all participants!
