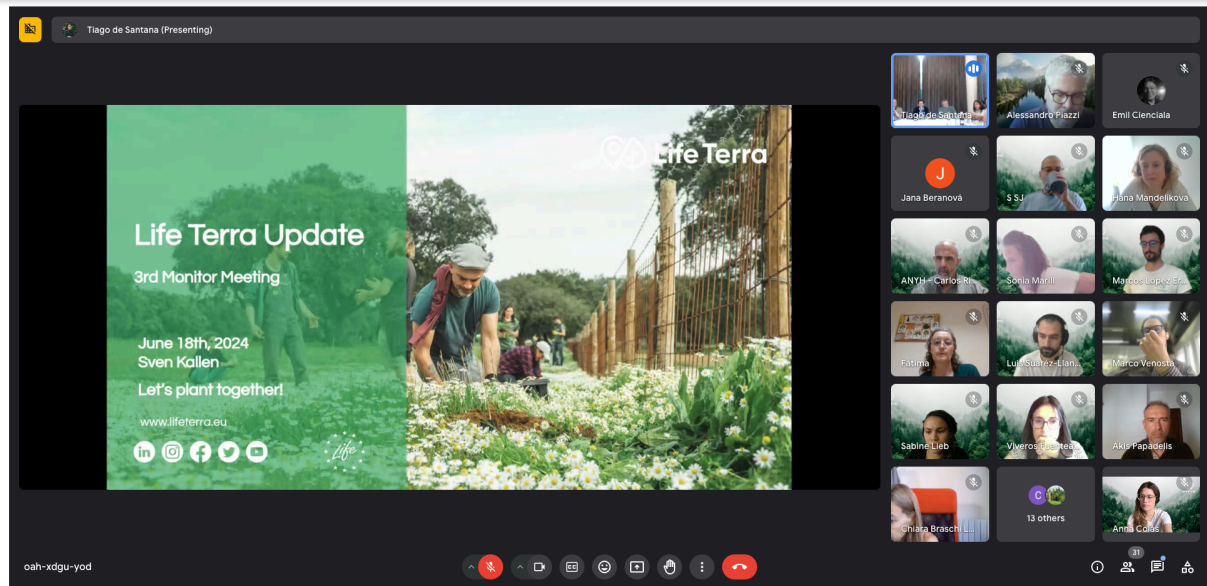

Recent Project Activities

3rd monitoring meeting of the project

On 18 & 19 June the Life Terra consortium came together to discuss the project's progress with the representatives of the European Commission during an online monitoring meeting. All partners had the chance to present their achievements in the fourth year of activities to the project officer, ask questions and get feedback on their administrative situation. A small representative group visited some planting plots during the second day.

Life Terra testing the EVA Wald-Klimastandard carbon removal credits in Germany

Life Terra has been looking into several different types of carbon removal credits to find which ones are best for each reforestation project.

In Germany, this work has now moved to the testing phase. We started working together with the EVA Wald-Klimastandard, and paid several visits to plots in which we have been planting. We have now understood which types of reforestation projects this specific standard is most suited for, and will continue testing further.

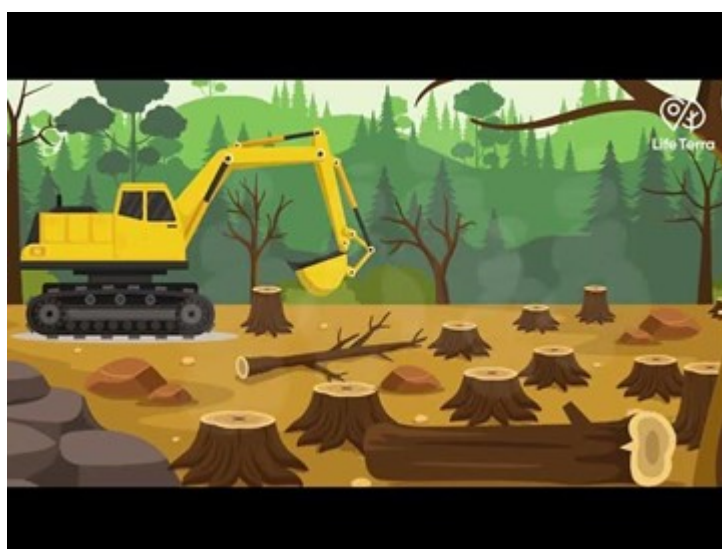

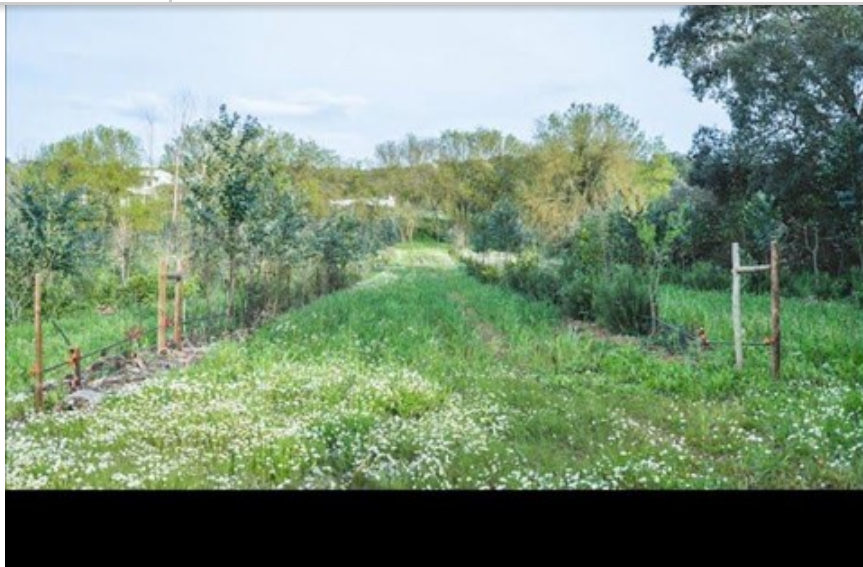
Euractiv video explainer: Healthy trees play a crucial role in mitigating climate change

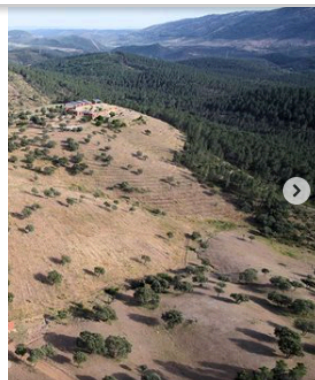
