**The European Tree Planting Day initiative is under way!**

For the first time ever, this fall marks the exciting launch of the very first European Tree Planting Day! By bringing together communities from around Europe through tree planting, we hope to create a yearly tradition that European citizens can follow to do their part to restore our wounded continent.

This month, our first EUTPD events have taken place around Europe, with people gathering in Spain and Lithuania to put trees in the ground. We are encouraged by the enthusiasm of the participants and by the high number of citizens that attended.

### 2024 Big Family Planting in Las Rozas

Las Rozas, a municipality just outside Madrid, has been hosting Life Terra planting events for years now. This time, it is one of the leaders in the European Tree Planting Day initiative too. Some of the first events of the initiative took place in the Spanish municipality this month, including a big family planting on 19 October. It was an open event in which families, friends and anyone wishing to take climate action could join and get their hands dirty with 14 different native species ready to be put in the ground.
