The city of Amsterdam needs more green!

The number of trees in Amsterdam is not growing at the same rate as the city. That is why Life Terra supported the Bomen voor Amsterdam' distribution campaign, organised by De Gezonde Stad (The Healthy City).

This foundation organizes projects and events to make the city more sustainable and greener. On 2 November, Amsterdam citizens could pick up a tree at four locations in the city to plant in their own garden or on their balcony. They could choose from two autochthonous tree species, the Wild Spindle and the Field Maple.

These species have been growing in The Netherlands for thousands of years and are perfectly adapted to the local environment. All trees can be registered on the De Gezonde Stad tree dashboard with Life Terra's tagging tool.

The distribution campaign was an overwhelming success! The action has left a positive and beautiful green impression in the city \mathbf{a}


