Recent Project Activities

Wrapping up the first European Tree Planting Day

The first edition of the European Tree Planting Day has now concluded. It was a success, with 45 organisations involved in 418 events across 19 European countries.

Life Terra played an important role in this initiative - it was, together with Nadace Partnerství, the driving force behind the creation of the Tree Planting Day - and is proud to record such large participation by the citizens, and such a large number of trees put in the ground.

Life Terra and Rosberg X Racing complete the Santa Vittoria restoration project

The island of Sardinia has often been hit by extreme environmental disasters in recent years, including widespread wildfires in 2022. After the wildfires, Life Terra stepped in to help restore the local flora, together with Rosberg X Racing, a racing team owned by former F1 driver Nico Rosberg.

Over the last two years, 4000 trees have been put in the ground, and the project has now been successfully completed. Some damage to the newly planted trees was recorded, due to wild animals and unusual weather patterns, but the trees unable to grow have been quickly replaced.

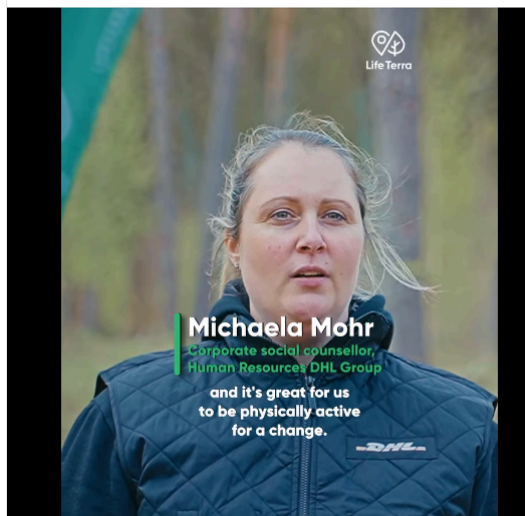
