10:00 am – Introduce and Discuss Avalanche report, hazard rating definitions, mountain weather and impact on snow

10:30 am In bounds- intro to gear- beacon, probe, shovel- assembly and use. Beacon drill

12:00 pm **Lunch provided – lunch discussion- Decision making**

1:30 pm BC Tour. Terrain intro tour- recognizing avalanche terrain, weather impacts, field obs of impacts, route finding

3:30 pm Back in bounds.

Sunday, February 4th

Day 2 – Route finding, companion rescue and decision-making in the BC

8:30 am Meet guides on the mountainside of the Tram dock, next to the RPK3 Restaurant deck.

8:45 am Discuss avalanche hazard forecast, recent avalanche events, and weather forecast. ID concerns for the day

9:30 am – BC tour- beacon rescue, route-finding, decision-making discussion (biases?), companion rescue 12:00 pm **Lunch provided**

1:00 pm BC Tour possibly 3 + 4- continue practice

3:30 pm Back in bounds.

4.15pm Après and wrap up event. RPK3 Restaurant, Teton Village
