- 1:00 PM Backcountry Tour. Terrain intro tour-recognizing avalanche terrain, weather impacts, route finding, field observations.
- 3:30 PM Back in bounds.

### Route finding, companion rescue and decision making in the backcountry

- 8:30 AM Meet guides on mountainside of Tram dock, next to RPK3 deck.
- 8:45 AM Discuss avalanche hazard forecast, recent avalanche events, weather forecast.
- 9:00 AM Backcountry tour. Beacon rescue, route finding, decision making.

- 1:00 PM Backcountry tour. Terrain selection exercise and stability tests.
- 3:30 PM Back in bounds
- 4:00 PM Camp wrap up après event- location TBD
