Leader to ensure no arrows are left after shooting, if so, leader to collect and hold them until ready to shoot again. Bows to be placed down behind quivers.	Safety brief required at all times for every new group participating. Arm guards to be worn if no adequate clothing. Safety netting to be in place behind bosses. Lower door to sports hall to be locked during indoor sessions.	1x2 = 2
