WILLIAM YANG STORY TELLING WORKSHOPS

Do you have a story to tell?

Performance 4A presents a rare opportunity for budding storytellers, playwrights, scriptwriters, poets and authors to join photographer and monologist William Yang for story telling workshops in Sydney on 15 & 22 March 2009.

The workshops will discuss participants' stories and their suitability for adaptation. Selected pieces will be developed over the two workshops.

No specialised skills in writing or performance are required to attend the workshops, although there is an obvious benefit if participants have an interest in these areas. Participants need not be Asian but their story should have an Asian or Asian cross-cultural theme.

Participants should bring a photo or photos or an object relating to their story. They may attend one or both workshops. Workshop II will further develop work begun in Workshop I, but will also cater for one-off participants.
