
The enclosed map marks out the areas for tonight's activities, with a full schedule of the performances, installations and music.

ABOUT THE ARTISTS

Yangjiang Group are Zheng Guogu, Chen Zaiyan and Sun Qinglin and tonight are joined by specialist calligraphers Li Pengxi and Chen Zhengang.

Founded in 2002 the group name themselves after their home town, a city in Guangdong province, where their principle studio is located. Their work is dedicated to reaching the widest possible audience often through creating ephemeral and participatory works. Yangjiang Group have been widely exhibited at prestigious galleries and museums such as the San Diego Museum of Art, USA; Tate Liverpool, UK; Kunthaus Graz, Austria; Mori Art Museum, Japan; and Guangdong Museum of Art and He Xiangning Museum of Art, China.

Watch as the Water Pavilion is transformed into a space of celebration and poetic splendour.

After Dinner Shu Fa 8.30 – 9.30PM Tea House Pavilion

Shu Fa, the Chinese term for calligraphy, has long been considered as an art of the Chinese elite. With After Dinner Shu Fa, Yangjiang Group bring a sense of humour and energy to the medium with a live performance that incorporates social observation, free form calligraphy and food scraps to create a sensorial and visually arresting work of art.

Tea Garden 9.45 – 10.45PM Tea House Pavilion

Inspired by the architecture of the Chinese Garden Tea House, *Tea Garden* is an intimate experience and a rare chance to share tea with Yangjiang Group. The performance is centred on the preparation and consumption of a cycle of teas, selected by the artists for their medicinal and therapeutic qualities.
