documentation of underground performance art from China. The exhibition will be held at the

Asia-Australia Arts Centre from 5 - 27 July 2002.

This video project is curated by Zhao Shulin and features some of China's most exciting

experimental artists using the medium of video to explore aspects of a changing identity,

economy and the effects of globalisation occurring in China.

Many Chinese artists have taken up their cameras to create art works. Through technology,

the differences in ideology between China and the West are no longer a major issue for

international communication. Instead people need to face many issues such as nationality,

culture, religion and the environment.

Their work reflects both the plurity and potential of the Chinese avant-garde art that now

tends to be 'multi-polar'. These video and performance works illustrate concerns that are

more closely related to the intermingling of regional and international culture and popular

culture. In their free and casual creative processes, these performance and video works deal

with traditional culture and its residual elements in today's culture by employing appropriation,

mixing, adaptation, fabrication, imitation and copying.
