Mark Hislop's investigations into the pharmaceutical industry have been described in a recent article in Art + Text as a proposition " that as commodities, art and drugs share a great deal, not least being the gentle imperative each issues: "Take me on trust".

He studied at Chelsea School of Art in London in the early 1990s and has held exhibitions at numerous artist galleries such as First Floor in Melbourne and First Draft in Sydney.

Tan Yi Feng's paintings explore themes of migration based upon his own journey from China to Australia. His quirky and at times surreal paintings evoke ideas of cultural difference.

Tan Yi Feng resides in Canberra. This is his first solo exhibition in Australia where he will present a series of new paintings.
