In this Olympic Year, Davey's installation at Gallery 4A, is timely, making comment on the "Going for Gold" desire for success, sports, winning, and the gold medals of the Olympic Games.

Based in Sydney, Andy Davey has participated in exhibitions at SH Ervin Gallery, Casula Powerhouse, Ivan Dougherty Gallery, Lewers Bequest and Penrith Regional Art Gallery as well as at The Sculpture Centre New York. As well as devising and participating in public art programs in both Sydney and New York.
