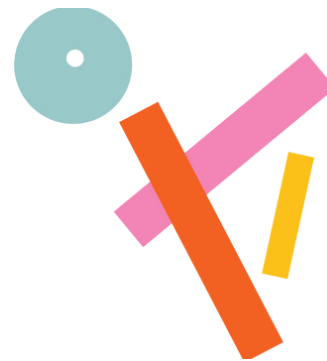

### **Structure**

External access	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Street with a stone sidewalk and a wooden walkway</li></ul>
Internal access	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The entrance is barrier-free, with no steps</li><li>• There are two entrances: one towards the lobby on the north side (from the garden) and one on the south side (from the neighborhood)</li><li>• Each entrance has three double doors. Each door leaf is 95 cm wide</li><li>• The doors have automatic opening via a presence sensor</li><li>• Each door features a vertical push bar, 40 cm above the ground and 200 cm long</li><li>• All door leaves have a pull/push handle</li></ul>

Theatre room	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ticket office with no steps</li> <li>• The maximum capacity is 70 seats</li> <li>• There are 10 wheelchair spaces (flexible)</li> <li>• If needed, a wheelchair can be requested for free at the entrance of the MUSE</li> </ul>
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## How to reach it

By car	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• You can park your car along the street (there are also spaces for people with disabilities) or in the paid parking garage beneath the museum. Parking is free for people with disabilities</li> <li>• We recommend visiting their website for Easy to Read access information: What it is and how to get there   MUSE</li> </ul>
From the train station	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Take one of the following buses: 2, 4, 12, 13, or 14, and get off at the stop 'ROSMINI CIMITERO,' or take bus 19 (Parking Shuttle) and get off at the stop 'Albere_MUSE'</li> </ul>

## Detailed information

Elevator	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The door is 90 cm wide</li><li>• The doorway measures 150 cm x 250 cm</li><li>• The control panel is located 96 cm from the floor</li><li>• Access to the basement is located at the end of the atrium, on the right</li></ul>
Restrooms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The restrooms are located in the exhibition halls on all floors, except for the 4th</li><li>• There are no steps</li><li>• The door is 80 cm wide</li><li>• The height of the toilet seat is 50 cm</li><li>• There are grab bars on either side of the toilet</li><li>• The height of the flush button is 96 cm</li><li>• Emergency pull cords are available</li><li>• There is no side shower or integrated bidet</li><li>• The height of the sink is 80 cm</li><li>• There is no escort service to the restrooms, but staff is available in the exhibition halls to assist</li><li>• There is a tiltable mirror that ranges from 100 cm to 170 cm from the floor</li><li>• There is a support rail</li><li>• Waste bins are available (for paper, general waste and diapers)</li></ul>

- Floor signage consists of 'footprints' that indicate the direction of the path
- Physical maps are available in 3D and braille
- There is a tactile model at the entrance and tactile maps of the exhibition halls on each floor
- Tactile maps are also available in the MUSE garden, the gardens and the biotope
