

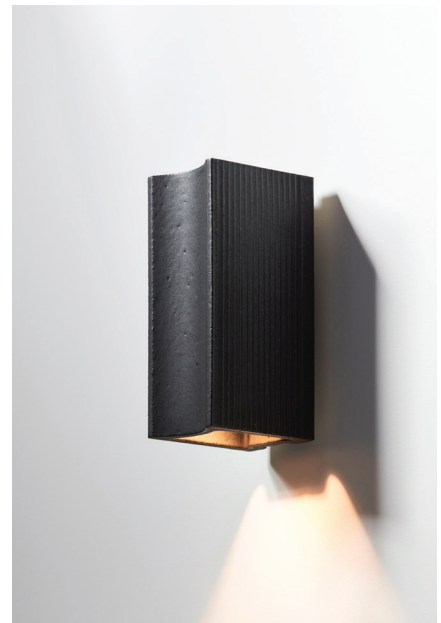

Flute builds on the exploration of material, form and process within the Anchor studio. The bold, curved face and fluted sides harmonise to create a sculptural and tactile fitting. The Anchor studio continues to expand its range of making methods and explore the design possibilities of clay. Flute is produced through a process of design thinking, traditional ceramic techniques and contemporary tools and methods.

Australian clay bodies are used to make Flute. The colour palette offered includes natural, dark grey, off-white, charcoal and white. The glaze finishes have been carefully tested and refined to enhance the material quality of each clay body. Inspired by place, Anchor's palette is developed inhouse to the highest standard. Clay body and glaze fit are developed together. After an initial firing, fittings are hand finished with glazes developed specifically for our lighting collection and then fired one final time.

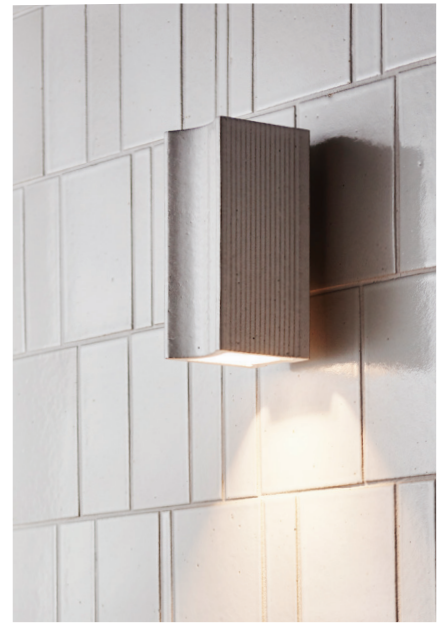
