What are cookies?

Cookies are files or pieces of information that are stored on your computer (or other Internet-enabled devices, such as your smartphone or tablet) when you visit a website. Based on expiration, we can use two types of cookies on the pages: session cookies and persistent cookies. Session cookies are temporary, i.e. they remain on your device until you leave our site. Persistent cookies will remain on your device for the time shown in the table above.
