Adults whose blood glucose is higher than normal but not high enough for a diabetes diagnosis have a 30% higher rate of hearing loss compared to those with normal. **OTOTOXICITY** There are more than 200 medications on the market today that are known to cause hearing loss. The list of known ototoxic drugs (toxic to the ears) includes




