

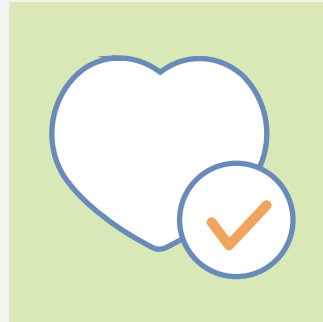
How Can Geography Help in Your Career?

Make you great at interpreting data



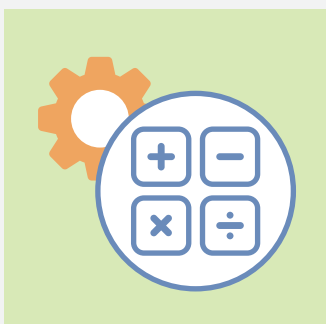
Your geography studies will require you to be able to take a set of data, interpret that data and draw conclusions from it.

Make you able to develop a reasoned argument



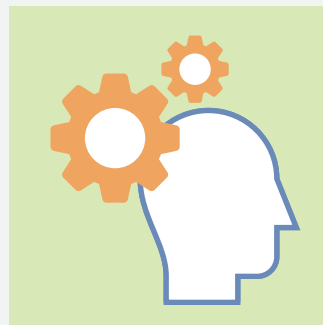
Your geography studies will require you to evaluate evidence and articulate your opinion on solutions to problems.

Make you a better communicator



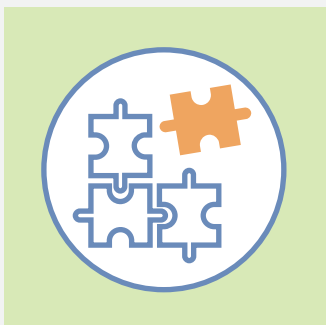
Your geography studies will require you to write reports and present data – all improving your written & oral communication.

Make you a creative thinker



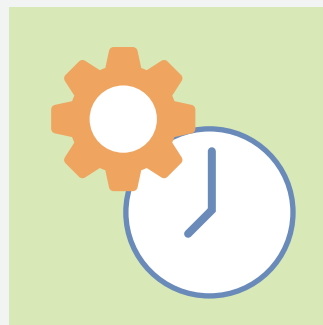
Studying geography will show you a variety of creative solutions to problems, teaching you to 'think outside the box'.

Develop problem-solving skills



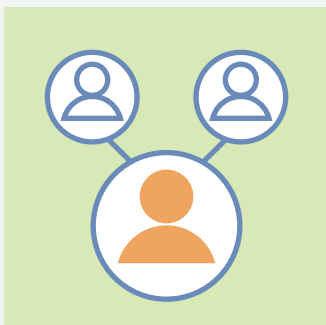
Geography offers plenty of opportunities to learn about various solutions to problems & improve your problem-solving skills.
