## Makes you a critical thinker



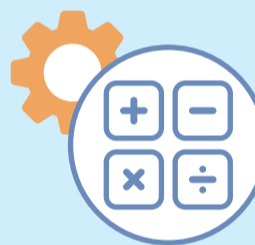
Science will teach you to critically evaluate information, question assumptions and make your own judgements based on the evidence.

## Develops time management skills



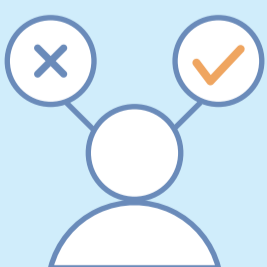
You'll need to manage your time to manage practical tasks and written coursework, and this is an important skill for any job.
