

5 Reasons to Study Languages

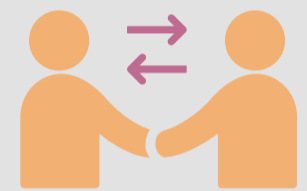


They will make you a better communicator

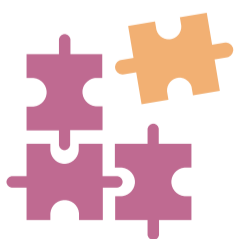


They will make you a more critical thinker
