



People in my Life Digital Walkthrough

This walkthrough will guide you through the practical aspects of using the People in my Life Digital v.2

Starting



Tap the **Book** icon to go to the walkthrough in the app



Initial session

Start by writing in a family name and tap the **OK** icon
Use a different name for each family



Follow-up sessions

Tap the **magnifying glass** icon to go to the archive screen where you will find previously saved files

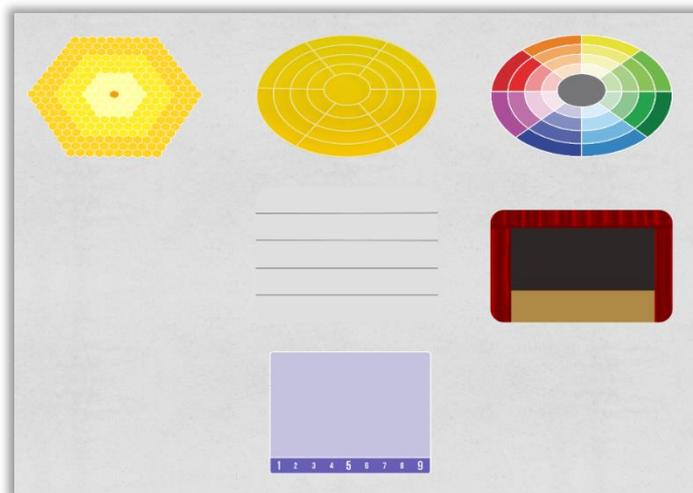


Use the search window to select a saved family file and tap **name**
A family file can be deleted here by tapping **X**

When a new family file has been opened, a new screen appears
Write the name of the first person who will be using the app in the window and tap **OK**

Choose the background you want to start with by double tapping



Changing Backgrounds



Tap the **Change** icon on the top bar, then double tap your selection.



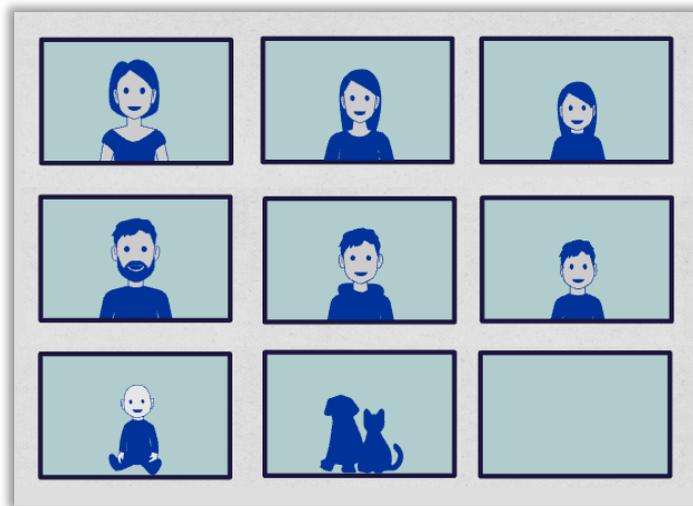
Selecting Figures



Tap the **Figures** icon on the top bar to add figures



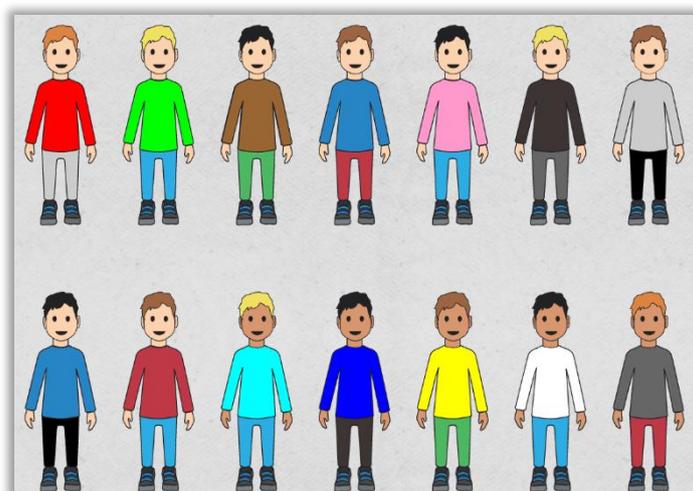
A screen showing the different types of figure appears



Tap to select:

Babies	Pets	

A selection screen appears



Tap to choose a figure, enter a name and tap **OK**



Figures can be changed to grey scale by tapping the icon on the lower right corner

When you have selected and named the figure you will return to the main screen

The chosen figure will appear under the bar at the top left of the screen

Touch and move the figure to place the figure on the background

The name of a selected figure is shown at the bottom left of the screen

Tap the **Figure** icon on the top bar to add more figures

Figures, labels and objects can be touched and moved at any time

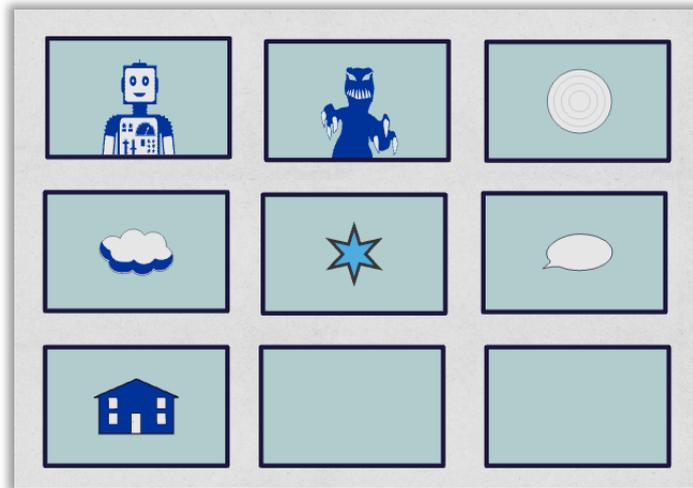
Adding Fantasy Friends, Trouble Trolls and Symbols



Tap the **Symbols** icon

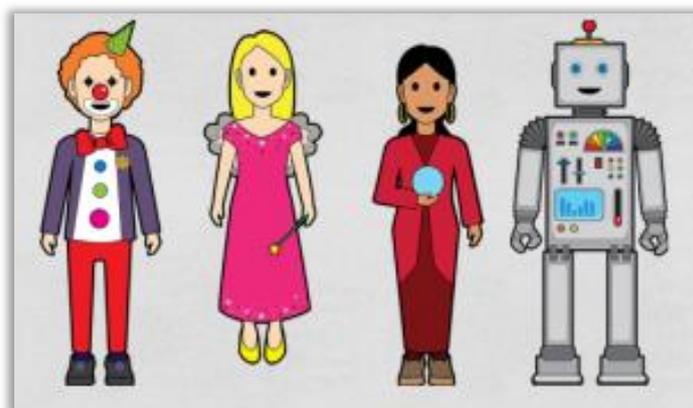


and the selection screen appears

Fantasy Friends can be used for solution-focused conversations with children

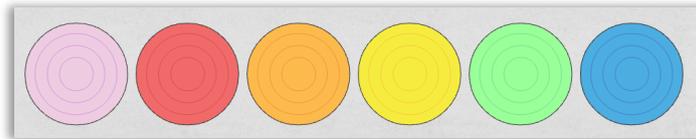


Trouble Trolls can represent relationship difficulties as externalized problems

Adding Labels



Tap the **abc** icon to add a written label to the background



Touch and move the label to place it on the screen

Editing

To change or remove a figure, label or object, tap it to select and then tap the **Edit** icon on the top bar



A menu window opens with 5 new icons



The **Pencil** icon changes names



The **Grey** icon swaps between colour and grey scale



The **Rotation** icon rotates figures 90°

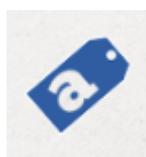


The **Flip** icon turns back and front



The **Delete** icon removes figures and objects

Displaying names



Tap the name Tag icon to display or to hide the names of all the figures

Lining-up the figures



The Line-up icon realigns all the figures under the top bar, where they are ready for new placements



This is useful when changing between family members or considering a different situation.

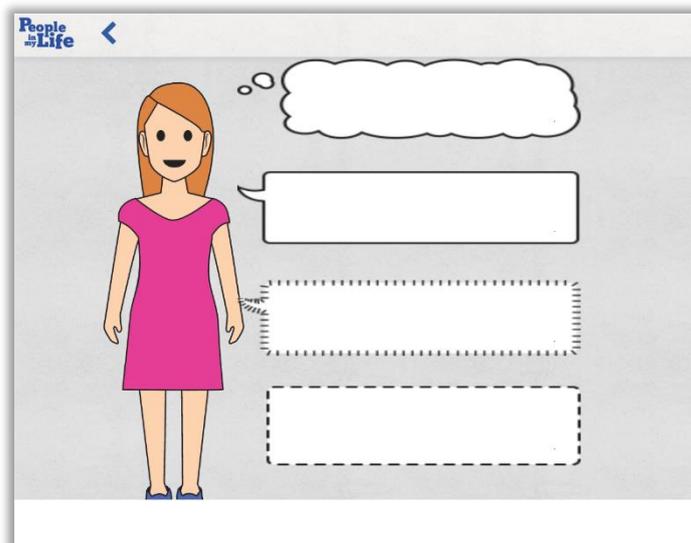
The thoughts and feelings screen

This function aims to assist family members to talk about how they have understood each other in problematic situations.

To enter the screen, tap to select a figure, then tap the **Talk-bubble** icon on the top bar



The selected figure appears on the left with 4 bubbles on the right and a space underneath



Key words can be written in all the bubbles

The top bubble is about thoughts

The next bubble is about speech

The third bubble is about feelings

The fourth bubble is about sensations

The area along the bottom is for key words about the situation

Tap the back arrow to return to the main screen

The key words are not saved after leaving this screen

Copying and keeping

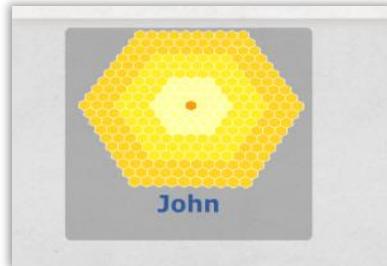
The positions of the figures on the background are saved continuously
To keep a particular position for future reference, a copy of the screen can be made
and you can then continue using the app with copy stored
This is particularly useful when changing between one family member and another



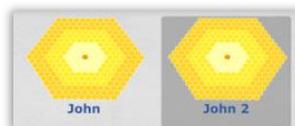
Tap the **Copy and Keep** icon on the left side of the top bar



Tap to highlight the screen



Tap the **Duplicate** icon to make a copy



Give the copy a new name and then tap to continue with it
while the original version is kept

To add a clear screen

To continue with a clear background without figures, tap the **Add** icon



Write in a new screen name and Tap to continue with a new figure selection



Editing screens



In this window the **Pencil** icon can be used to rename screens



and the **Delete** icon is used to delete them

Ending a session

To end a session, tap the **People in my Life** logo on the top bar



Choose whether to keep or delete. Deleted files cannot be restored

When you keep, all the saved screens will be stored and the final screen will return when you re-open the family file. The mentalizing screen is not saved.

Re-opening a stored session



A family file is re-opened in the start-up window, either by writing in the name for the family in the centre box or by tapping the **archive** icon, entering the first letter and then selecting the name from the archive screen



In the Archive screen, family files can be erased by tapping the delete icon



Family files cannot be retrieved after deletion
