Questions for Kathleen

- -Was there a part of the book that you had to rewrite?

- -Talk about the title. Why did the title get changed to Truth Be Told for the show? Did you have input in that?
- -Cover art change too?
- -How do you feel about the screen adaptation? Were you able to play a part in writing it?
- -As an author, how do you learn to take constructive criticism when the story and characters are so personal to you?

- -What is a book you wish you could read again for the first time?
- -What is the scariest book you ever read?
- -Do you have a favorite author?

Questions for others joining in live

- -Who was your favorite character?
- -Do you have a favorite moment from the book?
- -What is the meaning in the title: Are You Sleeping?
- -Which title do you like better, Are You Sleeping or Truth Be Told?

Generic on books...

- -What is your favorite psychological thriller?
- -What is the scariest book you ever read?

My favorite moments...

- -I loved the integration of social media and podcasts into the story. I thought it was so creative.
- -Favorite character was Poppy even though I hated her.
- question from the publisher... Josie feels steadfastly that the podcast has turned "[her] father's untimely death into a commodity" (p. 195) and "taken the single most horrible thing that's ever happened to [her] and repackaged it as entertainment" (pp. 196–197). To what degree do you think journalists have an obligation to treat living subjects with sensitivity? Does the need to inform the public outweigh the risk crime reporting runs of commodifying the pain and suffering of victims?
