About the Author

- -Jojo lives in Essex with her husband and 3 children.
- -Jojo was a journalist for 10 years and was writing on the side. Her first 3 manuscripts got rejected. She decided that if the 4th one was rejected, she was done. It was picked up.
- -Her first 6 books didn't sell very well. Then her 7th book was Me Before You.
- -You probably know JoJo for her book, Me Before You which was made into a movie and sold 14 million copies and spent 19 weeks on the NYT bestseller list. It was her 7th novel.
- -The Giver of Stars was her 12th book. When Jojo read the story of the pack horse librarians, she raced to KY to write the book because she was afraid someone else would write the story better. "Someone else might write it better but I will write it faster." She said this book came easy.
- -Jojo credits her days as a newspaper writer as helping her tell a story with conciseness and clarity
- -What other books have you read by JoJo?

About the Book

This book is about the women of the Pack Horse Librarians in the mountains of Kentucky. Information about the real life pack horse librarians...

- -Over the course of a month, women would ride and walk an average of 4,905 miles.^[23] The book packs that the librarians carried could hold around 100 books
- -The scrapbooks also contained cuttings from other books and magazines and eventually, there were more than 200 different books generated by patrons and librarians
- "Book women" were hired by the WPA and worked for around \$28 a month delivering books in the Appalachians via horseback or on mules.

Main Characters

Marjery O'hare- main character, abusive father, a woman who does not need a man. No nonsense, does not care what others think of her.

Alice van Cleve- english woman married to a spoiled man who doesn't want to have sex Sophia- african american woman who organizes the books

Izzy- girl crippled from polio, mom heads up the librarians

Beth- farm girl who joins the librarians

Katheleen- mountain woman whose husband dies of black lung, but joins the librarians
