



Laser Vein Removal

PPSD wants to provide you with the best possible result following your treatment. You can help to minimize the risk of complications by carefully reading and following your post-treatment care instructions. Ask us to clarify any item about which you have questions.

Pre-Treatment

- Arrive to the office without applying make-up or moisturizers to the areas you plan to treat.

After Treatment

- Immediately following treatment the area may show a slight redness with some swelling.
- During the healing phase, the area must be treated delicately. If a crust develops, let it fall off on its own. Do not rub, scratch, or pick at the treated area. Apply a thin layer of Aquaphor or Vaseline to the treated area several times a day to keep the area moist.
- Do not vigorously scrub the area; pat the area dry.
- Do not shave over the area of swelling, crusting, or scabbing.
- If swelling occurs, you may apply a cold compress wrapped in a cloth for ten minutes intervals to the affected area.
- Use a broad-spectrum UVA/UVB sun block SPF 40 or greater when the treatment area is exposed to the sun. Red hairs will exfoliate or push out in approximately 2-4 weeks.
- If you develop any blistering, fever greater than 101 degrees F, pustules, warmth, or redness around the treatment area, please contact the office immediately as these may be signs of an infection.
