

We have an exciting opportunity for a dedicated **Physician Assistant** within our organization.

**Job Responsibilities:**

This position is responsible for practicing medicine with physician supervision including conducting examinations and writing prescriptions. Within physician–physician assistant (PA) relationship, PAs exercise autonomy in medical decision making and provide a broad range of diagnostic and therapeutic services as well as surgery and surgical subspecialties.

- Round at affiliated hospitals as scheduled which includes all admitted patients as well as completing new consultations. Evaluate changes in patient conditions. Issue orders for medications, treatments, and lab tests. Discharge planning and E-Prescribing post op medications.
- Assess patient health by interviewing patients; perform physical examinations; obtain, update, and study medical histories. Determine abnormal conditions by administering or ordering diagnostic tests, such as x-rays, electrocardiograms, and laboratory studies; interpret test results.
- Perform responsibilities within the operating room, act as a first or second assist based on experience and case complexity.
- Triage and manage patient / Provider phone calls, including clinical decision making and documentation in a timely fashion.
- Review medication renewal requests including cross referencing Prescription Monitoring Programs with E- prescribing and documentation based on clinical decision making.
- Engage with Peer to Peer phone consultations with insurance-based Providers in order to assist with obtain need authorizations.
- Review and interpret incoming reports and lab data from Physician mail boxes, sign off and enact additional care as needed with supporting documentation.
- Take call as scheduled, providing 24 hour coverage for all LISS patient calls, hospital rounds at all needed hospitals, clinical decision making, and appropriate documentation both in EHR and Forums.
- Maintains professional and technical knowledge by attending educational workshops; reviewing professional publications; establishing personal networks; participating in professional societies.

**Qualifications:**

- Bachelor’s degree and successful completion of accredited physician assistant program
- NYS PA Licensure required
- Must possess a current CPR certification and current health records with the appropriate immunizations to work in the health care field (hepatitis B and tuberculosis)
- Ability to travel to various locations required

- Bi-lingual preferred
- Ability to communicate, both verbally and written, with all levels of personnel and patients
- Excellent attention to detail
