Job Description

The Washington State Fair **Barn Clean-Up crew** will maintain & clean the various animal barns during the fair. This year's dates are August 30- September 22 (closed Tuesdays and 9/4).

Duties include sweeping, pitching hay/straw, filling dumpsters with soiled animal bedding, moving full dumpster, wheel barrels, & placing fresh straw bedding in animal stalls. Candidates must like animals. Demonstrate positive hard working outlook that will reflect the Washington State Fair's high standard of customer service. This position is temporary with morning, afternoon and evening shifts available.

Physical Demands

Barn Clean-Up crew will require the ability to lift over 50 pounds, have a strong back , be able to stand, bend, & requires physical labor capabilities to accomplish the job. Strong physical labor skills include: lifting, loading, sweeping, farm-hand maintenance, and hard-working capabilities. Barn Clean-up crew must be able to work in farm-like conditions without allergies to animals, straw hay, or barn 'aroma'.

Education/Experience

Prior experience is preferred, but not required. Certification in forklift use is preferred but not required. Candidates must be able to take directions, demonstrate good common sense toward detail and safety.
