

Donation Policy: Washington State Fair

WHO IS ELIGIBLE to request a donation:

- 1. Must qualify for a non-profit status under the Internal Revenue Code
- 2. Educationally-based efforts (schools, etc.) in Washington state
- 3. Quality of life for children
- 4. Animal and agriculture education

Boundary of Support:

Donation requests to provide funds for ongoing running costs of the organization will <u>not</u> be supported, nor will these fundraising activities:

- Individual pursuits
- Debt reduction campaigns
- Political candidates or parties
- Good will advertising
- Conferences or meetings
- National or regional fundraiser held in various cities (i.e. Relay for Life)
- Beauty pageant participants

- Religious organizations (exception: nonsecular, if complies with Who is Eligible, above)
- Animal testing
- Organizations advocating violence or discrimination or in other ways promoting behavior inconsistent with our principles.

WHEN CAN YOU SUBMIT YOUR REQUEST?

If your auction is during these months:	Request accepted between these dates via Fax / Email / Mail (postmarked) / Hand delivery:
March, April, May	January 1-31
June, July, August	April 1-30
Sept., Oct., Nov.	July 1-31
Dec., Jan., Feb.	October 1-31

Requests will only be considered that arrive between January 1-31, April 1-30, July 1-31, and October 1-31 (based on auction date). If they arrive early or late, they will not be considered. Sorry, no exceptions.

WHAT YOU NEED TO PROVIDE:

If the organization meets the eligibility requirements, you are invited to submit for a donation <u>once a calendar</u> <u>year</u>. Please include the following information:

- 1. Submit your request on printed letterhead, including the organization's primary name, address, telephone, email and contact person.
- 2. Brief description of your organization, and purpose of the request
- 3. Either IRS 501 (c) (3) Tax Exemption Number OR copy of your IRS 501 (c) (3) Tax Exempt Determination Letter.
- 4. Must not exceed two pages
