Show Rules

We will be following all fair rules and ARBA rules as stated below.

1. During the Spring Fair, ALL vehicles must be off the grounds by 9 am or the vehicle will be towed.
2. All entry forms and payment must be submitted by mail no later than April 3 and by email no later than 6pm on April 6nd. No late entries will be accepted. The show reserves the right to limit entries.
3. All rabbit exhibits must be delivered to the Rabbit Show at the Spring Fair, 6 - 9 am April 16, 2020. Late entries will not be accepted. Check email the day before coop in for directions to enter the fair grounds.
4. Carriers must be removed from the grounds or they will be disposed of by show management.
5. All exhibitors attending the show must be responsible to an adult.
6. Exhibitors and parents are responsible for the completion and accuracy of entry forms. Exhibitors must fill out a master form that includes all entries. Improper or incomplete entries will not be shown. Entries will be judged as entered.
7. All rabbits must have a legible and permanent tattoo in left ear.
8. All showmanship rabbits must be entered into the type show.
9. This is a youth only show, exhibitors must be between the age of 5 and 19.

10. No talking to the judges during judging.
11. No ribbons can be displayed on cages.
12. Due to cage limitations, each exhibitor will be allowed fifteen entries. If there are cage openings, exhibitors will be contacted by the manager and openings will be filled by order in which entry is received.
13. All rabbits must pass disease and parasite inspection by veterinarians upon arrival and during the show. Inspect your rabbits! Clean rabbits are YOUR responsibility. Diseased rabbits will be rejected. The show management or vet will deny entry to any animal or exhibit they deem unworthy for public display.
14. The Rabbit Show will provide feed compliments of Purina. Feed is the property of the Spring Fair. It is not to be removed from the grounds. Rabbits will be fed and watered throughout the duration of the fair by the show committee. If you wish to feed and water your own rabbits each day please do so by 9am. Rabbit cages must be cleaned by 9am. Rabbits without food or water will be cared for by show committee.
15. All entries will be accepted with the understanding that neither the show organization, nor the Spring Fair or their officers shall be held responsible for any damage or loss that may arise to rabbits and other exhibits on exhibition.
16. Rabbits will be judged to the American Rabbit Breeders Standard of Perfection.
17. No sales will be permitted, nor will "FOR SALE" cards be allowed on cages or on Spring Fair property.
18. Arrival:
 - a. Rabbits will be received from 6 - 9am, April 16, 2020.
 - b. A Fair veterinarian will be present to inspect rabbits for diseases and parasites.
 - c. Rabbits will be cooped by class, breed, variety and sex for purebred rabbits.
 - d. All exhibitors are required to feed and water their own rabbits upon arrival, please provide your own feed and water crocks/cups for each animal exhibited.
 - e. Do not remove unused cage cards.
 - f. Each exhibitor will receive 4 entry tickets at check in.

All Exhibitors must participate in herdsmanship at least twice during the four-day fair, 2 one hour intervals. Sign-up sheet will be available at check in. This can include running rabbits on Thursday the 16^h for the type show, we will need help to do this efficiently.
19. Check out procedures:
 - a. Coop out begins at 7pm on Sunday April 19th, no exceptions unless previously approved by show committee.
 - b. Exhibitors will obtain check out packets from Show Committee.
 - c. Exhibitors will remove rabbits and supplies from coops back into their carriers.
 - d. Rabbit ear numbers will be verified with each exhibitor's paperwork before allowing to leave the barn.
20. We would appreciate past blue ribbon poster entries for display only. They may be turned in at coop in and will be returned at coop out. We hope to have a large amount of educational materials for the public to read and learn from.

Herdsmanship

This required program gives individuals additional responsibility in the rabbit show, offering an educational experience while meeting the public. All exhibitors must do two, one-hour shifts of

herdsmanship. Each shift requires two exhibitors, plus a parent, leader or instructor. If a group does not have an adult to participate, notify the show committee. Until all shifts have two exhibitors, no additional slots will be available. Signup for herdsmanship will be on check in day, after vet check. Each time slot is capped at two participants until all slots are taken. Help on Tuesday for the type show will be needed. We will need helpers to run rabbits, this will count towards herdsmanship hours and we need more than 2 volunteers for this.

This will be an Official ARBA show governed by the Official show rules as available at www.ARBA.net. All rabbits will be judged by the ARBA Standard of Perfection 2016-2020 edition.
