The Washington State Fair is pleased to offer young artists from the Northwest an opportunity to showcase their best work for the Korum Art Competition. Students, **grades 11-12 during the 2019-2020 school year** are invited to participate in what many consider to be the area's most prestigious show for the artistic community's younger generation. This competition is going virtual in 2020 in order to award scholarships in a timely manner for those potential winners who will be entering secondary education this fall. Students competing in the virtual competition can also participate in the JR/SR High Art Show and drop off their artwork once art intake has been rescheduled.

ENTRY GUIDELINES

- All work must be done exclusively by the student entrant, **grades 11 and 12 only**, within the current school year.
- **ONE ENTRY PER STUDENT** - Entries are limited to one per student. Students who submit multiple pieces will have one piece selected, at the discretion of The Fair, and all other pieces will be rejected.
- Register entries and upload images and scholarship form online. **We cannot guarantee against spelling errors. Please type carefully and use proper case for names and titles** when registering entries online.
- **All work must be titled!** "Untitled" is not allowed as a title in the show. **Untitled work will be retitled under the discretion of the superintendent or rejected at check-in.** We encourage that titles should be unique and individual, and **please keep them short.**
- The Fair reserves the right to reject any work it finds objectionable.

JUDGING

Artwork will be evaluated and judged on the following criteria:

- use of medium
- originality
- creativity
- composition
- design
- technical
- craftsmanship

This special competition is **only open to high school juniors and seniors** (2019-2020 school year).

Entries should **showcase** the uniqueness of Washington state - share what makes Washington special to you.

You may enter any of the following mediums:

- Computer Generated
- Printing

We ask that all artwork is **no larger than 20" x 20"**.
