Eligibility

Orchestra Wellington auditions are open to applicants who have the legal right to work in New Zealand. If you are not currently a citizen or a resident of either New Zealand or Australia, it is advised that you check New Zealand immigration law before completing your application. **Please note**: Orchestra Wellington is not able to provide sponsorship for overseas applicants.

Important Dates

Auditions will take place on Sunday 29 November, 2020 Entries close 5pm, Friday 20 November 2020 Recordings must arrive by 5pm, Thursday 26 November 2020

Application Procedure

- 1. Complete the online application form
- 2. Email your CV to <u>auditions@orchestrawellington.co.nz</u>

Please note: we reserve the right to pre-select candidates based on the applications received.

Audition requirements

Selection of orchestral excerpts and pieces (see documents on Orchestra Wellington website)

Auditions in person

Confirmation of auditions and further instructions will be sent to candidates via email immediately following the closing date.

Recorded Auditions

Recordings should be sent via Dropbox or Wetransfer (not email) to <u>auditions@orchestrawellington.co.nz</u>.

Requirements for recordings:

- Content must be exactly as per requirements and set list of orchestral excerpts.
- It must be a studio-quality recording.
- Recording engineer must confirm in writing that the recording is unedited
- Referee must confirm that the recording is a true and honest representation of the candidate's audition.
- The audition should be recorded as no more than two continuous takes, one take for the concerto material and one take for the excerpts.
- Each item on the DVD should be formatted post-recording as a separate track for easy access.
- A track list should be included.
- DVDs must be in a standard PAL format.
