The Flesh is Weak – Köttet är svagt

Saskia Neuman Gallery is thrilled to present artist Harry Anderson's first solo gallery exhibition, *The Flesh is Weak — Köttet är svagt*, opening on the 4th of May.

With a new suite of ceramic sculptures, Anderson explores traditional themes, distorted by his own sensual findings and insights. The exhibition indicates a new path for the artist, where the unpredictability of the material used is instrumental in setting the course and tone, guiding the artists' expression. The title of the exhibition has its origins in the biblical quote, *The spirit is willing, the flesh is weak*, referring to the human soul's qualities of striving and will, which are in turn finally defied by the weakness of the flesh. Born in Stockholm, Anderson holds an MFA from the Royal Danish Academy of Fine Art and has previously exhibited his work in Copenhagen and Stockholm, where he currently resides and works. *The Flesh is Weak* is Anderson's first solo exhibition at a gallery.
