VET Delivered to Secondary Students (VETDSS)

VETDSS is ideal for secondary students who are completing their VCE, VCE VM, or VPC and want to gain practical skills in a specific industry. Students will complete a two-year Certificate II or III VETDSS program, attending class once per week (either a morning, afternoon or evening).*
