1.2 Key Safety Directions

4. DESCRIPTION & FEATURES

eMOTUS5016 is a low impedance (16 ohm) loudspeaker cabinet, 5" woofer with eMOTUS unique design.

Ready for indoor and outdoor applications, thanks to its aluminium grill and UV protection treatment (IP65-rated). A professional and compact loudspeaker, cost-effective and with a unique design that will easily fit in a massive number of applications: theme parks, gardens, nature parks and urban spaces, leisure, health and sport centres, residential buildings, outdoor areas, etc. Available in black and white colour.

Wall mount accessories and safety sling are included for an easy and secure installation.

6. CONNECTING

When connecting a 16-ohm speaker to an audio system, proper wiring and impedance matching are essential to ensure optimal performance and avoid potential damage to your amplifier.

Follow these guidelines for a safe and efficient setup:

1. Check Your Amplifier's Compatibility

Before connecting the speaker, verify that your amplifier supports a 16-ohm load. Many amplifiers are designed for 4, 8, or 16-ohm speakers, but it is crucial to check the manufacturer's specifications to avoid mismatching impedance, which can lead to reduced performance or equipment damage.

2. Use Proper Speaker Cables

Always use high-quality speaker cables with adequate thickness (gauge). For longer cable runs, thicker cables (lower gauge numbers) are recommended to reduce resistance and maintain signal integrity.

3. Correct Wiring and Polarity

Ensure that the speaker is connected with the correct polarity:

- The positive terminal (+) of the amplifier should be connected to the positive terminal (+) of the speaker.
- The negative terminal (-) of the amplifier should be connected to the negative terminal (-) of the speaker.

Proper polarity ensures that the speaker moves in sync with other speakers in a multi-speaker setup, preventing phase cancellation.

4. Series and Parallel Configurations

If using multiple speakers, you may need to wire them in series or parallel.

For a 16-ohm speaker:

- Parallel connection: Reduces the total impedance. For example, two 16-ohm speakers in parallel create an 8-ohm load.
- Series connection: Increases the total impedance. Two 16-ohm speakers in series result in a 32-ohm load.

Ensure that the total impedance matches your amplifier's output capacity to avoid overloading or underutilizing the amplifier.

7. INSTALLATION & OPERATION

In the packing of eMOTU5016, you will find all that is needed to complete installation of the unit.




The following should be observed as general rules:

- Always install on solid, firm surfaces.
- For good sound reproduction, there should be no hindrance between the units and the audience.
- Adjust the levels of sound pressure to reproduction requirements. Despite its small size, the eMOTUS5016 has a performance far higher than that of domestic loudspeakers.

Procedure for installing on a surface:

- 1. Make three 6 mm drill holes in the wall, lining them up with the position of the holes in the bracket.
- 2. Insert three 6 mm wall plugs in these holes.
- 3. Fasten the safety line on the back of the bracket.
- **4.** Place the bracket in position, after first passing the line and the loudspeaker cable through the square hole on the bracket. Fix the bracket to the wall.

5. Connect the loudspeaker cable to the connector on the rear part of the box, using the Euroblock connector supplied.

• Ensure the correct polarity of the terminals and that the cable goes through the square hole in the bracket.

It is advisable to place the protective housing supplied when the loudspeaker is installed outdoors.

6. Place the acoustic box in its final position, vertically sliding it downward so that the rail on its rear side fits with the bracket rail.

Fasten the safety cable on the rear part of the acoustic box, to avoid it accidentally falling and causing material and/or personal damage.

7. Orientate the box to obtain the required position on the vertical and horizontal axes. Tighten the Allen screws on the bracket to fix said position on both axes.


