1.2 Key Safety Directions

4. DESCRIPTION & FEATURES

NIMBO-14 is a premium performance 2-way passive loudspeaker with 40W RMS power, in a compact size with extended low frequency response. Suitable for outdoor applications, with a cloud-inspired design, result of Ecler's engineering skills and the collaboration of architects and interior designers.

Including 1×4 " woofer and a 1" silk tweeter located in the acoustic centre, acting as a single point source to disperse the sound evenly.

It includes a wall-mount bracket (inox), allowing tilt and pan adjustment using a single screw.

4.1 Main Features

- 2-way passive loudspeaker for surface mounting.
- 1x 4" woofers with 4-layer voice coil improves power handling and low frequency response.
- 1" silk tweeter with neodymium magnet and ferrofluid.
- 8Ω nominal impedance.
- Glass-fibre reinforced ABS non resonant compact enclosure.
- Wide dispersion pattern.
- HANDY wall-mount (inox) versatile pan and tilt bracket included. Quick and easy to install, including jumps and markings for repeating speaker orientation.
- Weather-protected with an IP-44 rating.
- Available in white (RAL9003), black (RAL9005), gold colour (RAL1036, approx.) and titanium colour (RAL9007 MATT).
- RAL paint customization available.





5. CONNECTIONS

The connection cables which connect the amplifiers output and the speaker should be of good quality, have sufficient conductor area and be as short as possible. The latter fact is especially important when the distance is long and the load impedance low (8 Ω). A cross-section of at least 2.5mm2 is recommended for distances up to 10m; 4 or 6mm2 for longer distances. Following formula gives the required section, assuming 4% losses:

Cross section in mm² =
$$\frac{\text{Length in m}}{\text{Loudspeaker impedance in }\Omega}$$


Always respect the polarity. The loudspeaker has an INPUT Euroblock connector, and a second STACK Euroblock connector thereby facilitating the parallel connection of speaker.




5.1 Connections Diagram







5.1 Outdoor installation



In outdoor installations, use a round tool to drill the grommets.

Avoid making straight cuts. Additionally, ensure the use of round profile cables instead of parallel cables.

7. RECOMMENDED AMPLIFIER

The output power of the recommended amplifier for NIMBO-14 is 80W RMS.

8. POSITIONING & INSTALLATION

8.1 Positioning

Consider following general rules.

Place the speaker on a solid and firm surface. No obstacles should stand between the enclosures and the audience. The high frequencies are very directive compared to the low frequencies, so that any obstacle will impair their response. In case large audiences must be addressed, a better long distance sound propagation will be achieved if the enclosures are flown high enough.






8.3 Installation Diagram


Mounting the bracket


