What you need to know

On 15 March, the Australian Government put in place new measures for people arriving in Australia:

· Individuals must self-isolate for a period of 14 days on arrival to Australia, including returning Australian citizens and residents.

You are also required to self-isolate if you:

- have been diagnosed with the Coronavirus (COVID-19)
- are under medical assessment for Coronavirus (COVID-19)
- has been in contact with any confirmed coronavirus (COVID-19) cases.
