(<https://www.purplemash.com/>) Each morning, teachers will post on the **2Blog** platform outlining the key learnings for the day. Every child, has their log in and will be able to access remotely from home. Children have been shown how to use this platform to drive their own education forward and are familiar with the layout. If they have questions there is a **2Email** application which allows them to contact their teacher directly.
