With this number of the Bulletin is enclosed a letter from the National Spiritual Assembly which is of the greatest importance. The Local Spiritual Assembly appeals to each member of the London community to ponder this letter decyly.

On the Sundry immediately before this Bulletin was sent out, the need for this letter was demonstrated at the afternoon meeting. Only three members of the community and one visitor were present. At 3.30 p.m. when the meeting was supposed to start, there was no one at all at the Centre, and it is known that at least one visitor went away because, finding nobody there, he thought there was no meeting that afternoon. Surely in a community possessed of the fire which attracts souls to the Cause of Bahá'u'llah, such a thing could not happen.

In order to discuss this letter from the N.S.A. and the affairs of the community as a whole, the 19-Day Feast of Asná (at 7.0. p.m. on 20th August) will be held as a special meeting. Besides the usual reports, part of the time will be devoted to a general discussion of these problems. This is a matter of the utmost importance and the Assembly appeals to you to be present at this meeting.
