It is no longer time to tarry. The recent messages which our beloved Guardian has sent us, clearly and unmistakably indicate the measure of effort and sacrifice required. Let us humbly pray to become worthy of the station to which he calls us. Let us serve the Cause of God and our fellow-men with a devotion and constancy, never before equalled in our midst. Let us rise unitedly and whole-heartedly to pursue our sacred task. Therein lies the hope of a bewildered, distracted and tormented world.

And now here is the plan for the year in outline:-

Public Meetings:

Beginning in July, on the second Friday of every month (August excepted), we will hold a public meeting at the Alliance Hall, Palmer Street, Westminster, which is across the road from one of the exits of St. James's Park Tube Station. This arrangement will continue until December, and in 1947 these meetings will be held on the second Tuesday of the month. Time: 8 p.m.

Sunday Meetings at the Centre:

On the last Sunday of every month, we shall have a formally conducted public meeting with a speaker and discussion. Other Sundays, the meetings will be varied with devotional programmes, musical items, socials, children's parties, share out of the news of the Cause, etc. Time: 3.30 p.m.

Hyde Park Meetings:

Beginning June 2nd, every Sunday (except Whit-Sunday) at 3 p.m., a meeting will be held at the Speakers' Corner in Hyde Park (opposite Marble Arch).

19-Day Feasts:

New arrangements are made for conducting the 19-Day Feasts. A week before each feast, these will be posted to the host or the hostess. A table for the year was drawn up and sent with the April bulletin. If the Feast apportioned to you is not convenient, please notify the Secretary in good time.

Committees:

Seven Committees are appointed, the membership of which will be given elsewhere in this bulletin. Once these committees function efficiently the Assembly will be relieved of routine matters and can concentrate on the extension of teaching work, service for the Six-Year Plan and the general welfare of the Community.



This is a plan. The Assembly cannot by itself make it a resounding success. We all are in it and by united and collective effort we can assure its fulfilment. So to the task. May the grace of Baha'u'llah be our guide and shelter.
