We are the instruments through whom His healing love can flow to mankind - but we are channels only if we are united and love one another - and we cannot do this if we do not meet.

'Abdu'l Bahá said: "The Nineteen Day Feast was inaugurated by the Báb and ratified by Bahá'u'lláh in His Holy Book, the Aqdas, so that people may gather together and outwardly show fellowship and love, that the Divine mysteries may be disclosed. The object is concord, that through this fellowship hearts may become perfectly united."
