Teaching Conference

The next Teaching Conference will be held at Birmingham on January 5th and 6th 1957. It will be the seventeenth of the series which originated from a meeting of the National Spiritual Assembly in Manchester in December 1936, attended by believers from Bradford, Blackburn and Birmingham. At the Convention of 1937 it was decided to hold the first Teaching Conference in December 1937. At this Conference twenty-five believers were present, including nearly all The National Spiritual Assembly, and it was decided to ask the Assembly to promote thrice annual gatherings for the National Community: Convention, Summer-School and Teaching Conference.

Teaching Conferences have since been held every year except the last two years of the war. This year, the third of the Ten Year Crusade is rapidly passing and many tasks remain to be completed and many victories to be won. It is up to you to do your share, so come to the Conference.
