Here we are giving an abridgment of a very important letter from the National Teaching Committee, that was read at the Nineteen-Day Feast on September 27th.

"The Ten Year Crusade has passed its half-way mark, and has already produced victories around the world which we would have thought impossible in 1953. During the same period, the world has been lurching from crisis to crisis, becoming more deeply enmeshed in the toils of its own perversities, careering perilously along the brink of the chasm of its own self-destruction. Between these two processes there is a close relationship. The ultimate safety of the world at large, depends directly upon the success of the Ten Year Crusade. the shoulders of the small company of Bahá'is, rests the responsibility of deciding the direction in which mankind will move during the next centuries of On our exertions now depends the happiness and safety of our children, and our children's children for decades ahead. Since the passing of our beloved Guardian the significance of this responsibility has become more apparent. The Day-Spring of Divine Guidance is lifted from this world. the establishment of the Universal House of Justice, will return a source of Divine Guidance. And the establishment of that infallible, divinely-guided Body, depends on the complete success of the Ten Year Crusade. country, twenty-five more local Spiritual Assemblies must be established by Of the chosen goal towns, eleven are as yet empty of Baha'is. therefore appeal to you, members of the pivotal Centre of England, to examine your situations, whether you are British or Persian, settled families or students, young or old, and after fervent prayers, decide in your hearts the service that you can render the Cause of God in these critical months and years Then arise to rescue mankind from its appalling plight." ahead.
