

London Extension Teaching

In an effort to mobilise the teaching and pioneering goodwill of those believers who are obliged to study or work in London, the London Assembly has, with the approval of the N.S.A., chosen three suburban towns outside the boundaries of the London community, for development by extension teaching and pioneering to Assembly status. It is thought that a number of believers may be willing to live in these towns and travel into town to work daily, as hundreds of thousands of London workers always do. The towns chosen are Epsom (South of London), Romford (East), and Watford (North-West). There are already three believers now living in Epsom with hopes of another soon. We ask the friends to think seriously, if their work ties them to London, whether they could not go and live in one of these towns. All have good communications with central London, good schools, etc. If you would like to consider pioneering and cannot leave London, please discuss the matter with the Extension Teaching Committee (Secretary: John Wade). If other goal towns fail to make the grade by 1963, some of these towns could be instrumental in achieving our part of the Ten Year Crusade.
