Suitable for all ages, parental supervision may be required. One potion bottle per person.

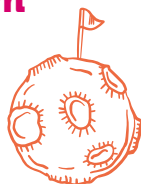

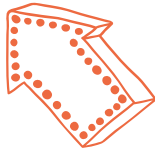
Friday 27 October
